The Greeks, Phoenicians, Arabs, and Italians have all held sway over Sicily. Though the Greeks brought their advanced viticulture techniques, Sicilians have been making wine since 4000 BC. Its dry, warm climate features regular sunshine and moderate rainfall that suits wine production. Arid conditions reduce the chance of rot and mildew, especially in areas kissed with coastal breezes. This makes Sicily a prime candidate for organic farming.

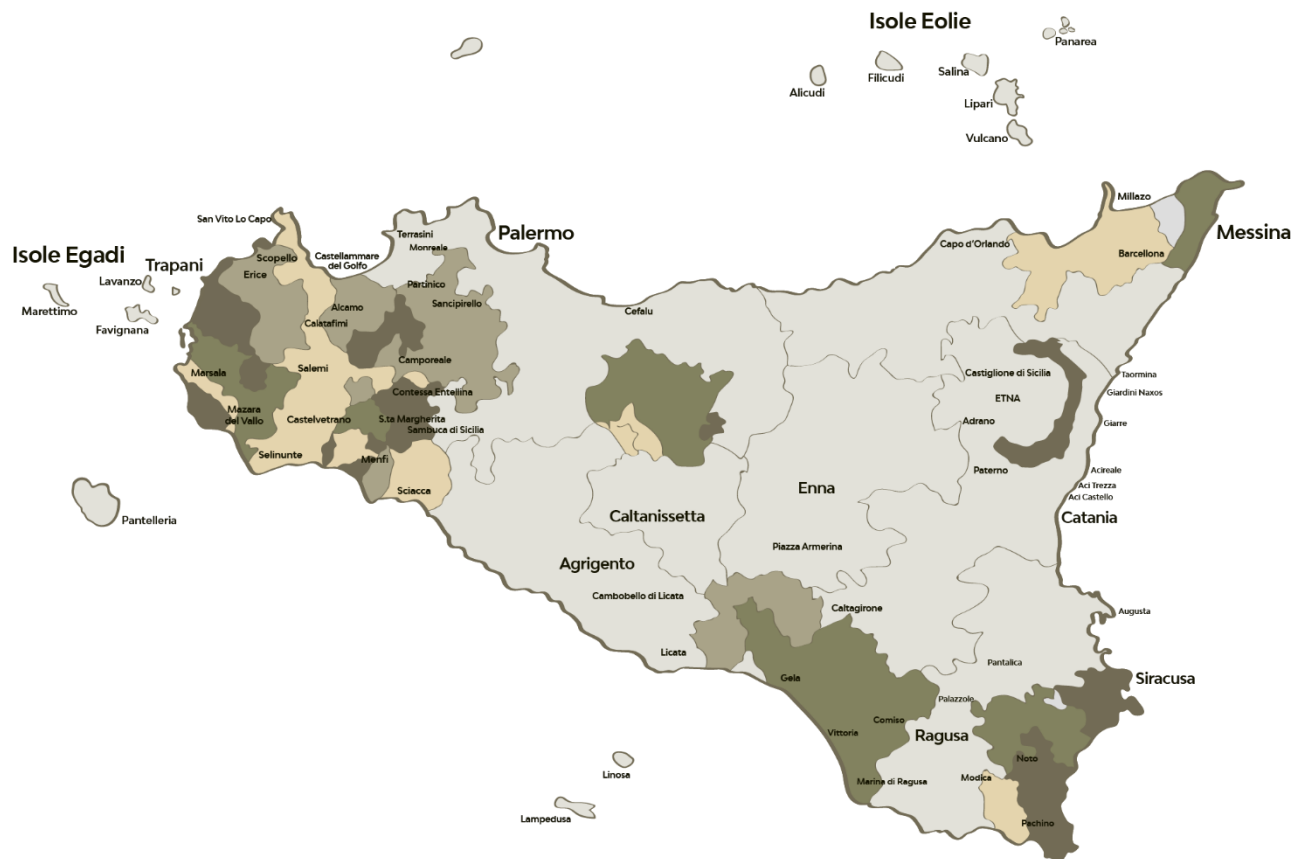

## SOME FACTS

Sicily is Italy's southernmost region and the largest island in the Mediterranean Sea. For more than 2500 years Sicily (800 b.C.) has been a significant centre of Mediterranean viticulture, although the reputation and style of its wines have changed significantly over that time. The island was once most famous for sweet wines (Muscat of Pantelleria and Malvasia delle Lipari) and later fortified Marsala.

Today many of its best-known wines are dry table wines. At its widest point, Sicily measures 280 kilometres (175 miles) east to west, and about one third that distance north to south. Its roughly triangular shape led the island to be dubbed Trinacria (the triangle) during the Middle Ages and is reflected in the triskelion (a motif with three protrusions) at the centre of the



regional flag. Blessed with consistently bright sunshine and reliably moderate rainfall, Sicily's classic Mediterranean climate is ideally suited to the production of wine grapes. The warm, dry climate means that mildews and rots are kept to a minimum, particularly in well-ventilated areas that benefit from coastal breezes. This low disease pressure means that chemical sprays are hardly needed, so much Sicilian wine is produced from organic grapes. Sicily has 24 **D.O. "Denominazioni di Origine"**: 23 *DOC, Denominazioni di Origine*

*Controllata* (DOC) and one *DOCG*, Denominazione di Origine Controllata e Garantita. Sicilia DOC is a broad, island

## FRANCIACORTA & PROSECCO

**Franciacorta** is a section of the province of Brescia, Lombardy, Italy. It is known for its wine production of the 'Italian Champagne', using the traditional method of Champenoise, where the fermentation with the addition of sugars and yeast takes place in the bottle, unlike the Charmat method which uses fermentation in an autoclave and subsequently bottling. The duration of the fermentation is Officially regulated and Certified by the Law between 18 and 24 months, only after this period can be officially sell it on the market.

# SICILIAN RED WINES

## ETNA ROSSO-NERELLO MASCALESE



Etna's unusual grapes, Nerello Mascalese and Nerello Cappuccio, are only part of the story. Another piece is the stone terraces that follow old lava flows to create contrade, or crus. The system is likened to the fastidiously delineated vineyards of Burgundy, which are organized by landscape and whose soil composition creates nuances in the final wines.

They are nimble and nuanced wines, toned by the bright berry fruit and the strikingly dusty, ashy notes that are considered a part of the terroir's dark, volcanic intrigue.

As a late-ripening variety, Nerello Mascalese almost perfectly reflects the personality of each harvest and provenance of the wine, much like pinot noirs and nebbiolos do. The Etna Rosso wines that champion the cool and rainy vintages, like 2018, are also more likely to transmit that pinot noir red-fruit elegance and sensibility with a bit of herbal, ashy, sulfurous wildness.
